Today, i.e. 17 November 2011 the Management Board of Polimex-Mostostal SA was notified about the fact that the bid for the construction of two power units No. 5 and No. 6 with the output of 2 \times 900 MW in Elektrownia Opole was selected as the most advantageous one.

The bid amounts to:

PLN 11,558,310,000.00 gross.

The bid was made by a consortium of:

Polimex-Mostostal S.A. - partner

Mostostal-Warszawa S.A. - partner

The share of Polimex-Mostostal amounts to 41.77% (PLN 4.828 million gross).

The main scope of works of Polimex-Mostostal includes the construction of the turbine island with infrastructure. Furthermore, the Company is to execute the

electrical installations with control and measurement instruments as well as automatic devices. It will also participate in design works.

Polimex-Mostostal, being a national leader in the execution of industrial investments, has been developing its activity in the power engineering sector for many years. It has adequate competences and experience and, what is more, it is capable of comprehensive execution of large power-engineering projects.
